- We meet on the second Monday of the month at the Fayette Co Public Library at 6pm.

- We are overseen by Purdue Extension. We receive no funding from Purdue.
- Our annual dues are \$10 per person or \$12 for a family.
- At this time, we maintain the courthouse urns and area between east entrances, Clio Fountain(large pie shape portion), 27th St Park Entrance, and Amtrak shelter flower garden on Eastern Ave. Last year we also assisted in preparing flower gardens at The Hope Center and Fayette Co Animal Shelter.
- We provide gardening educational programs throughout the year.
- Our purpose is to share gardening information and meet the gardening information needs of our community.
- We award a \$500 scholarship each year to a student pursuing a career in horticulture or an agriculture related field.
- We sponsor 4 awards at the 4-H fair in the vegetable and flower gardening departments.
- Spring Fling is our annual fundraiser, a festival type of event, which includes our plant sale and a variety of vendors. We also have speakers and gardening demonstrations for all ages. It is at the Miller Building Gym, the second Saturday in May from 9am to 2pm.
