FINAL ORDER IN GARNISHMENT

Comes now the Plaintiff and this proceeding having been submitted to the Court on the Judgment Creditor's Affidavit, and it appearing to the Court that the Judgment Creditor is the owner of an unpaid Judgment against the Judgment Defendant, and it further appearing that the Judgment is due, in amounts in excess of those exempt from execution.

The Court having heard the evidence and being duly advised, now finds that the facts set out in Judgment Creditor's Affidavit are true, and that Judgment Creditor is entitled to recover of and from the earnings of Judgment Defendant's in the amount required to satisfy said Judgment with interest and costs, until same is fully paid and satisfied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DECREED that the Sheriff of **FAYETTE** County levy on said income due or to become due to said Judgment Defendant, from said Garnishee Defendant, who is hereby ordered to pay into the hands of the Clerk of this Court at least monthly the **LESSER OF:**

- (a) 25% of total disposable earnings per week; OR
- (b) Total disposable earnings less \$154.50 per week to be applied upon the Judgment rendered in this cause in the sum of \$ _____ until the unpaid balance is fully paid and satisfied.

Disposable earnings means that part of the earnings of an individual, including wages, commissions, income, rents or profits remaining after the deduction from those earnings of amounts required by law to be withheld.

Garnishee Defendant may collect the fees authorized by I.C. 24-4.5-5-105 (5).

This order shall be effective only after all prior final garnishment orders have been fully satisfied and paid.
